

Keeping Conrad’s Hospital Ready for Your Family

Your local hospital, emergency room, rural health clinic and long-term care facility are all housed in a **county-owned building**, a building that belongs to every Pondera County resident. Keeping it safe, code-compliant, and structurally sound is our shared responsibility.

What This Levy Does

- This is not a new tax.
- Pondera County voters approved a mill levy for this same purpose in 2014, and it has been in place for 12 years.
- You are being asked to **renew** it for eight more years at the same rate, beginning in tax year 2026.
- Levy funds are used exclusively for building maintenance, structural repairs and code compliance.
- Levy funds released requires approval from the **Pondera County Commissioners** and **Logan Health – Conrad Board**; a locally appointed board made up of your neighbors, accountable to this community.

What It Costs You

Home Market Value	Estimated Annual Cost
\$100,000	\$15.89 per year
\$300,000	\$47.67 per year
\$600,000	\$95.34 per year

The total levy is \$253,341, plus an inflationary adjustment allowed under Montana law.

What’s at Stake

- Without this levy, Pondera County has limited ability to fund major building repairs. Deferred maintenance doesn’t disappear, it compounds, driving up costs and leaving code compliance and essential services at risk.
- In rural Montana, distance matters. Conrad’s hospital exists because the community has chosen to sustain it. This levy preserves that choice and protects local access to care.

Vote YES to renew the mill levy.
